

## Fringe Halter Crochet Top

This pattern is an adorable summer top and can easily be customized! It's easy for any beginner to work up. Anyone with crochet experience will be able to adjust for infant or older. Add your own embellishments to make it one-of-a-kind.

Difficulty Level: Beginner

## Materials:

- G Crochet Hook
- Worsted weight yarn (I used acrylic but you can use cotton too)
- Yarn Needle

Size: 12-24 Months

## Pattern:

Chain 41
Row 1: DC in $3^{\text {rd }}$ chain from hook and each ch across. (40) Turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 **skip one, 1 dc chain 1, skip one, 1 dc** Repeat across . (40) Turn.
Row 3: Ch 2.1 dc in each chain across. (40) Turn.
Row 4: Ch 2. Dc2tog, 1dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (38) Turn.
Row 5: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (36) Turn.
Row 6: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (34) Turn.
Row 7: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (32) Turn.
Row 8: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (30) Turn.
Row 9: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (28) Turn.

Row 10: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (26) Turn.
Row 11: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (24) Turn.
Row 12: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (22) Turn.
Row 13: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (20) Turn.
Row 14: Ch 2 Dc2tog, 1 dc across until the last two stitches, Dc2tog. (18) Turn.
Row 15: Ch 2. ${ }^{* *} 1 \mathrm{dc}$, chain 1, skip chain** repeat across. (18)
Chain 100 to form strap and tie off. Attach yarn to opposite corner and chain 100 to create the other strap, tie off. Weave ends. Attach fringe to bottom. I added tassels to ends of straps but you can leave them plain too. Now take straps and thread them like a corset through the top and bottom end stitches. See pic below.
